- INMATE TESTIMONY -

I woke up on December 31, 2021, intending to leave our home in Wichita, KS, to meet my husband in Enid, OK, for lunch. We also planned to do a little gambling and defraud a loan company. God had other plans.

Throughout my life, I've had the opportunity to follow the Lord, but I've always gotten distracted with my selfish desires and addictions to gambling, money, and methamphetamine.

We'd only been married a month.
Our arrest in Enid was a real
wake-up call for me! Later, after I
was transferred to Mable Bassett
Correctional Center for women, I
picked up a book titled, GOD'S
GRACE LIBERATES! by Sharla
Yoder. That book broke the chains

of guilt and condemnation off me because I was listening to Satan's lies, telling me, "You blew it. God will never be able to use you."
While reading that book, I heard God speak to my heart that He had allowed me to be moved to a foreign place (prison) where He wanted to restore me to become a vessel with a testimony that He can use to impact many others!

I learned through Sharla's book that Jesus has set me free from sin, and by His grace I have true freedom in Christ, and I am not condemned according to Romans 8:1. I began attending Redeeming Love Prison Ministry's chapel services and learning my identity in Christ and to be disciplined and speak God's truth in love, boldly!

God used RLPM to restore my backslidden relationship with the Lord, and to completely deliver me from drugs, alcohol, and gambling. I went forward for special prayer with one of RLPM's ambassadors. It is very difficult to get approval for correspondence with a spouse at another prison. But we prayed, and God gave me favor to now write to my husband, praise God!

I have now been transferred to Eddie Warrior Correctional Center (EWCC), and I'm so thankful that RLPM also ministers here as well!

At the first RLPM chapel service I came to, **Candy Wilson** preached a powerful message on God's love and how it is meant to be given away to others! Because I was abandoned as a child, I have been able to overcome a lot of hurt and have had a major breakthrough! My spirit is refreshed and revived
