## **God Transforms**

**Drug Dealer with Life Sentence** 

— Inmate Testimony —

On my 21st birthday, June 21,1993, I was in a bar fight with three guys who were harassing my fiancée. When I intervened, I was very drunk and got beat with a baseball bat and my throat slit before being thrown from a moving truck, and later ran over by a car! Due to the prayers of my mom and grandmother, I know

God spared my life for a purpose!

I already had four DUI's and was awaiting trial. I woke up three days later in St. Francis Hospital, ICU, with my jaw wired shut, a hole in my windpipe, shattered

teeth and cheekbones, and my eyes knocked out of socket and put back, and a steel plate in my forehead. My reconstructive surgery took over eleven hours.

Redeeming Love Prison Ministry

My doctor put me on Demerol pain shots every three hours, and two weeks later, I was addicted.

After I was released, I switched to

meth. I have been drawn to God and His Word many times while in prison. In August of 2008, I was released from prison, and was living a fairly good life when my dear mother passed away, throwing me into a tailspin! I began

manufacturing and selling meth again, and basically living only for the devil.

I paid my huge bond with drug money, but left town, and was on the run for two years, when I was picked up by the U.S. Mexico Border Patrol and extradited back to Oklahoma. I was given another 20 years on top of my already hefty sentence. Last year, I was given commutation for my life sentence, so I only have about twelve years left. I believe that my heavenly Father heard my prayers of repentance and gave me favor through my Lord Jesus Christ!

When I was at Davis Correctional Facility in Holdenville, OK, in 2017, I came across a book by Sharla Yoder, titled, GOD'S GRACE LIBERATES! This book has really impacted my life! So much so, that I wrote down the address in my own notebook, so I could write Ms. Yoder at a later time. I often struggle with loneliness and other emotions. The devil likes to whisper in my ear that I am worthless and that because my own family has disowned me, why would God want me in His family? I have written letters to them and begged them to forgive me. But they don't think I have or ever can change, after being a drug dealer with four incarcerations.

But when Ms. Sharla visited my cell at OSP, where I am locked

down 23 hours a day, 7 days a week, and I realized how much she cared, and had written that book I read, it really touched my heart. The fact that she encouraged me to write my testimony for you, also really pulled on my heart strings, because I want to write a book someday to help other addicts, and maybe this is a start.

To the partners of RLPM, I would like to say thank you for caring enough to support this ministry so they can visit prisoners like me and share God's love!

I pray that RLPM will keep on doing what you are doing! It makes me feel so blessed to see someone at my cell door, asking how I am doing and actually caring about my welfare, my relationship with the Lord, and praying with and for me! So again, I say thank you for making all this possible. May God BLESS this ministry! Thank you!
