
#### AFTER PRISON SUCCESS IN CHRIST!

Note: Sophia Carbajal shared this beautiful testimony <u>live</u> at our 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Banquet. You will enjoy the amazing victories in Jesus she acquired in prison!

I grew up in Alamogordo, New Mexico. My mother is a Godfearing woman, but my father was an alcoholic and heroin addict. He was a *very* abusive man physically, emotionally and sexually. My mother worked a graveyard shift, so my siblings and I were left alone with my father at night. He always came

home from work drunk or high. As a young girl, I could not understand how the man who was supposed to love and protect me could shatter everything meaningful in my life! He stripped me of my innocence, self-worth, confidence, hopes and dreams. I kept my shameful secret, hoping someone would hear my silent cry and rescue me, but no one did.

At age 12, I began to experiment with marijuana and alcohol to try to numb my pain. I became pregnant at age 15, but the baby's father did not stay with me. I was an abandoned teenage mother. I managed to graduate high

school while I worked part-time and was partying. I then began to traffic drugs from Mexico to El Paso, Texas. Soon I was arrested and sentenced to 3 years federal probation. I continued my addictions and began to traffic interstate. I was arrested again in the Panhandle of Oklahoma in 2011. I was facing 25 years to life in prison, hundreds of miles from home. I was scared, hopeless, miserable, and had no purpose or peace.

My mom took me to church as a child, but later I was so angry

with God for what I went through with my father's abuse! In court, I pleaded guilty as charged and through God's mercy was sentenced to only fifteen years at Mabel Bassett Correctional Center in McLoud, OK. After every vice was taken from me, I finally realized my greatest need was Jesus Christ. I dropped to my knees and asked God to take control of my life! I was determined and asked God not to allow me to walk out of prison the same woman I walked in. I was blessed to begin my college education and did what I could to better myself. I became a chapel orderly, and it was there that I met Sharla Yoder, and she invited me to attend

Redeeming Love Prison Ministry for the first time.

I immediately felt the presence of the Holy Spirit in this ministry. I attended on a regular basis and was soon operating the sound system for them. God began to move in my life in a mighty way! At one of the invitations at RLPM's chapel service, I went up for prayer, and Sharla Yoder prayed with me about my daughter, Melissa. She began to change and is now sober and serving the Lord—glory to God! Angie Davis also became a mentor to me in the Mentors program through RLPM on Monday nights. As she shared God's Word with me, it became alive in my spirit. I was introduced to Sharla's book, God's Grace **Liberates!** as we studied it in Mentors. It had a great impact on my life as I realized how much I have been forgiven and redeemed by God's grace. I am so grateful and blessed for Redeeming Love Prison Ministry (and other ministries) that take the Word and the Spirit of God into prisons. In November, 2017, it was one year that I have been paroled from prison. I am now at *His House Ministries* in Claremore, OK, owned by former inmate Rhonda Bear. I manage this group home for former inmates and also manage a Christian coffee house called *She Brews*.

I have been clean and sober for 6 years, and I am a God-fearing woman who strives for integrity and continues to lead women to the Lord. I am active in my church and have learned to place my confidence in God and not man. I pray that my story has ministered to you. I now have direction, purpose, peace and joy! Thank you for allowing me to share, and God bless you!

### **HEART TO HEART**

I am so very grateful to God and to you for your prayers for my surgery last year. I have recovered well from it now. However, I have another health situation that I am trusting God to take care of.

In 2015, I had two stents placed in the main (center) artery to my heart. They have recently totally collapsed and I am told are buried into the tissue and calcified. The result is I don't have much energy and often have angina chest pain because insufficient blood is getting to my heart when I am active. (This has slowed me down considerably as I have to pace myself with rest.) My former cardiologist said that there was nothing they could do...the risk was too great to remove the stents. One of our board members referred me to another cardiologist for a second opinion, which I got. He believes removal of the stents and restoration of the blood flow is a possibility, but needs to see the film (not just the report) to decide if he will refer me to a heart surgeon. (I'm not sure if he is thinking about a bypass.) If this is God's will, I believe that He will bring me through it victoriously!

Again, I deeply appreciate your prayers, and I believe that God is more than able to take care of this situation! I have much peace, knowing what God's Word promises and that the price was already paid for my healing by Jesus at the cross! I believe that I have a very bright future on this earth with much yet to accomplish for His glory, Amen! I am asking God for a miracle surgery without doctors, because I know that there is NOTHING too hard for Him! Thank you again for your agreement in prayer.

I believe that 2018 is going to be an awesome year for each of you wonderful partners and for RLPM! Together we will reach many more prisoners with God's life-changing Gospel of heart transformation... YES!

Thank you for your generosity. Without your support, we simply could not do what God has called us to do.
